2. One of the parents is Fiona Fleming who works with children and young people for DCC. She is keen that the NP should include childrens play and she will be at the consultation to help.
3. AT to send summary of what an NP is to everyone -thanks to ML for writing this.
4. AT and AW to return to school to engage younger children to do a painting and older children to write about 'their Modbury'

Consultation.

1. RS has three table top panels A1 size. The self supporting panels are Ao. RS thinks there may be 4 of these, but will investigate with Peter Watts help.
2. We have agreed to use the 'sticky' method - encouraging the public to note down thoughts on stickies and sticking them onto large blank sheets with headings. CR agreed to design and print up A1 sheets for all the heading types. (ML has since found coloured blank sheets, so we shall revert to printing headings and any text on A4 and attaching them to blank sheets.
3. ML to revise NP summary information and CR to add logo and print at A2 or A1.
4. **Headings** - should we add examples for 'consideration'? The number of heading will be determined by the number of display boards we have. I have grouped similiar heading in colours so if we don't have enough boards these subject areas could amalgamate.
